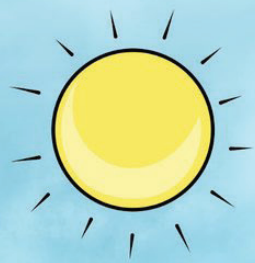

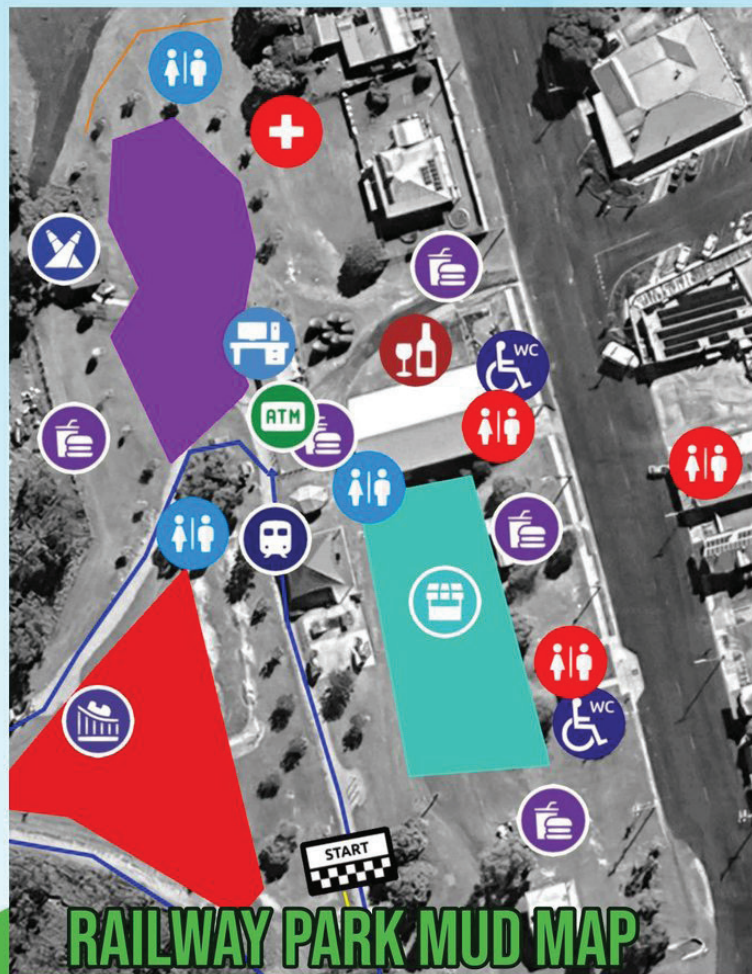

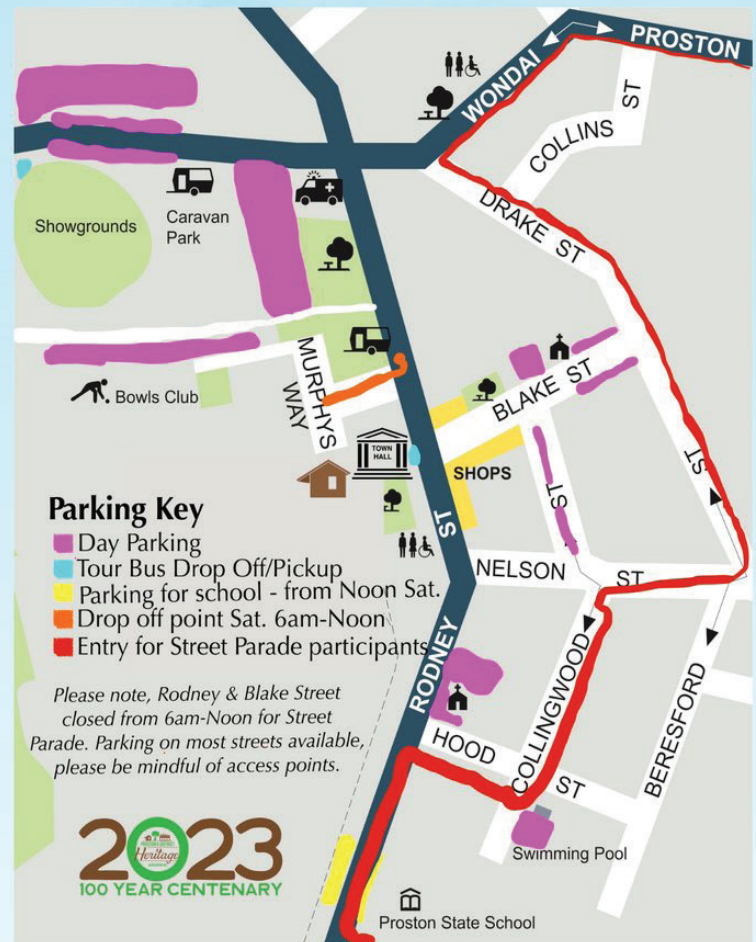
## Event Office and Official Souvenir Stall at the old Railway building
