

Press Release dated 18 October 2014 2015 Boondooma Dam Yellowbelly Fishing

Boondooma Dam Yellowbelly Fishing Competition spokesman Terry Allwood says that with dam levels estimated to be around 70% in early February the annual competition to be held on 7 and 8 February 2015 should provide great weekend of fishing and family activities.

Fishing conditions at Lake Boondooma will be at their best, the water quality should be good and significant weed beds have now formed.

Entry costs for 2015 will remain at \$20 for adults and \$5 for juniors aged 16 years and under. Competition entry fees do not include the cost of camping at the lake. Registrations will be accepted for the fishing competition from 1230pm on Friday 6 February at the stocking association clubhouse, with a competition briefing at 8pm.

For the 2015 competition the catch and release section will be available to suitably equipped anglers. In each session the longest Australian Bass caught, measured and released will attract a cash prize and a trophy will be presented for the best overall Australian Bass caught and released.

The fishing and family fun weekend is a major fundraiser that supports the ongoing stocking of Lake Boondooma.

Accommodation available at the lake includes 5 self contained cabins, a communal bunkhouse, powered sites, non powered lakeside camping areas and modern amenities blocks. For information on camping fees go to the South Burnett Regional Council website www.southburnett.qld.gov.au
