



2015 Boondooma Dam Yellowbelly Fishing Competition Press release dated 13 January 2015

The Boondooma Dam Fish Stocking and Management Association are confident that the weather will be great for this year's Yellowbelly Fishing Competition. The water quality is good and the dam is fishing at its best since recent record flood events. Boondooma is currently at 71%.

The 2015 competition is scheduled for 7 and 8 February and the camping area managers have done a great job to ensure the camping area and facilities are ready for the expected big crowd.

Ongoing support from event sponsors, both old and new, has ensured a wide range of prizes and lucky draws are available for competitors. This year will boast a 3.6m aluminium boat donated by Lake Boondooma Kiosk, there will also be two kayaks donated by Freak Sports Australia.

This year's event will also include a catch and release section for Australian Bass and Yellowbelly with cash prizes at each weigh-in as well as the usual competition format.

Food and drinks stalls will be provided by local community groups over the weekend and entry costs remain at \$20 for adults and \$5 for juniors aged 16 years and under. Nominations will be accepted from noon Friday at competition HQ. With a new addition being a briefing and prize give-aways at 8pm on the Friday night.
