

# Show Regulations

---

1. Proston Show is conducted subject to the Constitution and Rules of this Society and any Regulations which apply to individual sections. If any situation arises which is not covered by the Society's Constitution, Rules and Regulations, then the Constitution and Rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies shall prevail.
2. The Society will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any accident, loss, damage or misdelivery of livestock or any other exhibit which may occur at any time covered by Show activity, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Association blameless and indemnify it against any cost or action, legal or otherwise arising through any accident, loss, damage or misdelivery. All care will be taken but no responsibility accepted.
3. It is the responsibility of Exhibitors and Space Hirers to comply with the current Workplace Health and Safety Act together with all State and Local Government Regulations and space hirers must have their own Public Liability Insurance and produce identification when requested.
4. Exhibitors and Space Hirers who bring electrical equipment for use on the grounds must comply with all current legislation.
5. All persons entering the Showgrounds during any period covered by Society activities shall abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Proston Show Society and will pay admission on Show Day unless issued with an approved Show Society pass.
6. The President, Steward and/ or Committee person in charge of any section of the Show has the discretionary right to refuse an entry by an Exhibitor at any time, without expressing reason, if the Society reasonably believes it is necessary to do so in order to maintain the standard, quality and safety of the Show.
7. Pavilion Stewards have the right to make new classes where not listed in the schedule, provided there are two or more entries.

8. The Society reserves the right to refuse entry to any Stall Holder if the Society reasonably believes it is necessary to do so in order to ensure that the standard, quality and safety of the Show is maintained.
9. ALL Competitors compete at their own risk.
10. All Prize money, Special Prizes and Ribbons must be collected on Show Day.
11. In order to comply with the Society's insurance requirements, ALL incidents must be reported to a member of the Committee who will complete an Incident Form.
12. ALL Livestock Exhibitors must have current Public Liability Insurance.
13. All livestock and plants entered into the Proston Show must be free of disease.
14. During any period covered by Show activities, all Livestock must be the responsibility of the Owner or Owners representative.
15. Livestock Stewards have the right to arrange for the removal from the grounds, at the owners expense, of any beast found to be diseased, dangerously uncontrollable or otherwise unfit for the purposes of Exhibition.
16. Any objections or protests should be submitted to the Secretary in writing for consideration at the next General Committee meeting of the Society.
